Maximise efficiency through rationalisation and automation.

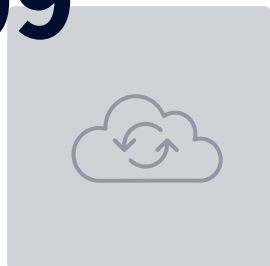
